The association is a non-partisan, non-governmental and non-profit organization, freely and voluntarily associated physical and legal entities which advocates and promotes the interests and well-being of people in a disadvantageous position: respect for regulated dignity, personal autonomy including a person's freedom of choice and independence; respecting diversity and accepting disability as part of human diversity and humanity; equal opportunities; accessibility; equality of men and women.

Any kind of discrimination regarding race, skin color, gender, language, religion, political or other belief, national or social origin, property, birth, or some other circumstance is not allowed in the work of the Association.

GOALS OF THE ASSOCIATION


The Association was founded with the aim of promoting, developing, and improving:

MISSION AND VISION


VISION






